ERRATA REGARDING GOVERNMENT’S SENTENCING MEMORANDUM

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully submits this errata regarding the government’s Sentencing Memorandum filed on February 8, 2023 (ECF No. 55). At the time, paragraph 61 of the draft Presentence Report (PSR) stated that, in February 2000, the defendant was charged with “Obstructing Police (Ct. 1), Narcotic Equipment Violations (Ct. 2) and Obstructing Justice (Case# 2000-00009631).” (ECF No. 50 at ¶ 61). Citing paragraph 61 of the draft PSR, the government’s Sentencing Memorandum stated on page 18: “In addition, in 2000 and 2001, Puma was charged for obstructing police (twice) and with obstructing justice. PSR at ¶¶ 60-61.” (ECF No. 55 at 18). The final PSR no longer reports the arrest previously listed in paragraph 61, which the draft PSR incorrectly attributed to the defendant. (ECF No. 61 at ¶ 61). Consistent with that correction, the government’s Sentencing Memorandum should be amended to state on page 18: “In addition, in 2001, Puma was charged with obstructing justice. PSR at ¶ 60.” An amended Sentencing Memorandum is attached as an exhibit to this filing.
