The failure to comply could result in dismissal of the indictment or information, dismissal of individual charges, exclusion of government evidence or witnesses, continuances, Bar discipline, or any other remedy that is just under the circumstances. MINUTE ORDER. Consistent with the discussion during the status conference held on April 1, 2022, a status conference is set for June 1, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. via videoconference. For the reasons stated during the April 1 status hearing--namely the need for the defense to review voluminous and forthcoming discovery and the need for the defense to determine how best to defend this case, see 18 U.S.C. 3161(h)(7)(B)(iv)--the Court finds that the "ends of justice outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial." 18 U.S.C. 3161(h)(7)(A). Accordingly, pursuant to the Speedy Trial Act and with the consent of the defendant, the time from April 1, 2022, through June 1, 2022 shall be excluded in computing the date for a speedy trial in this case.
