ORDER

This matter having come before the Court pursuant to a Motion to Continue, upon consent, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that, after taking into account the public interest in the prompt disposition of criminal cases, the Motion is **GRANTED**; it is further

**ORDERED** that the preliminary hearing and status conference currently scheduled for October 26, 2021 be continued for good cause to December 28, 2021 at 1 p.m. before Magistrate Judge Faruqi; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the time between October 26, 2021 and December 28, 2021 be excluded from calculation under the Speedy Trial Act. The Court finds that the ends of justice served by the granting of such continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and Defendant in a speedy trial, as the continuance will afford the parties additional time to engage in pretrial negotiations so that they can potentially reach a resolution.
