MINUTE ORDER as to DANIEL CHRISTMANN: The Court has received the parties' 29 Joint Motion to Continue as to DANIEL CHRISTMANN. The Motion indicates that that parties agreed that a 90-day continuance "would assist the parties in their ongoing plea negotiations and in allowing additional time to provide and review ongoing discovery disclosures." Mot., ECF No. 29, at 1-2. The Motion further indicates that defense counsel is "unavailable" between January 8, 2022 and January 24, 2022. Accordingly, and upon good cause shown, the 29 Motion is GRANTED. The NOVEMBER 10, 2021 status hearing is VACATED. It is further ORDERED that the parties shall appear for a status hearing on February 10, 2022 at 10:00 AM ET. The hearing shall occur via videoconference. It is further ORDERED that the time period between November 4, 2021, and February 10, 2022, shall be excluded from the computation of time under the Speedy Trial Act. The Court finds that such a continuance serves the "ends of justice" and outweighs the best interests of both the community and Defendant in a speedy trial. 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A). Specifically, the Court finds that the voluminous discovery and complicated "nature of this prosecution" render this case "so unusual [and] complex" "that it is unreasonable to expect adequate preparation for pretrial proceedings or for the trial itself within the time limits established" under the Speedy Trial Act. Id. at § 3161(h)(7)(B)(ii). In particular, the exclusion of time through February 10, 2022, will allow both the government and Defendant to address and review discovery in this case, within a reasonable time frame. Moreover, this continuance serves the ends of justice in light of complications caused by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. See Standing Order No. 21-62 (BAH) (D.D.C. Nov. 1, 2021), at 6-7. Defense counsel has concurred with the above continuance of Defendant's rights under the Speedy Trial Act. See Mot., ECF No. 29, at 2. By or before DECEMBER 3, 2021, Defendant shall submit a signed statement confirming whether he, himself, consents to this continuance of time under the Speedy Trial Act. Taking into account the continuance outlined above, the Court has calculated that Defendant's new 70-day deadline is APRIL 21, 2022.
