

Forfeiture or Release of the Bond

At the request of the United States, the court may order a judgment of forfeiture against the defendant and each surety for the entire amount of the bond, including interest and costs.

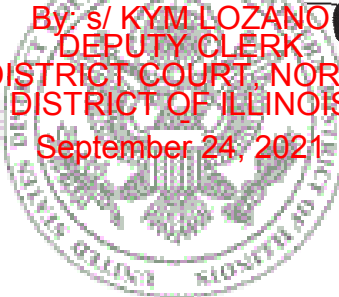

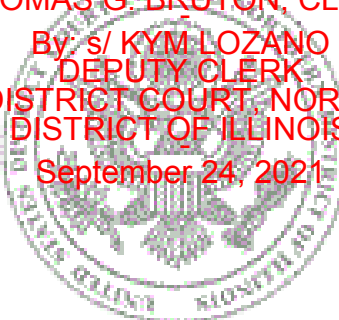

Failure to disclose may result in various consequences, including but not limited to: exclusion of evidence, adverse jury instructions, a mistrial, dismissal of charges, vacatur of a conviction or guilty plea, disciplinary action against the prosecution, and contempt proceedings.
