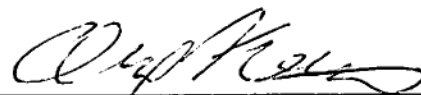
① Could you provide us a more detailed definition of "independently unlawful means" (p. 24 of instructions)?
