MINUTE ORDER as to DOMINICK MADDEN. In light of the pending appeal in United States v. Little, see generally Docket for Crim. Act. No. 22-3018 (D.C. Cir. Mar. 24, 2022); the Court hereby sua sponte ORDERS that the sentencing hearing is STAYED pending the outcome of the appeal. "A trial court has broad discretion to stay all proceedings in an action pending the resolution of independent proceedings elsewhere." Hisler v. Gallaudet Univ., 344 F. Supp. 2d 29, 35 (D.D.C. 2004) (citing Landis v. North Am. Co., 299 U.S. 248, 254, 57 S. Ct. 163, 81 L. Ed. 153 (1936)). The court "must weigh competing interests and maintain an even balance," when determining when to stay a proceeding. Landis, 299 U.S. at 254, 57 S. Ct. 163. "The power to stay proceedings is. inherent in every court to control the disposition of the causes on its docket with economy of time and effort for itself, for counsel, and for litigants." Air Line Pilots Ass'n v. Miller. 523 U.S. 866. 879 n. 6 (1998) (guoting Landis, 299 U.S. at 25455), "Indeed. 'a trial court may, with propriety, find it is efficient for its own docket and the fairest course for the parties to enter a stay of an action before it pending resolution of independent proceedings which bear upon the case."" IBT/ HERE Employee Representatives' Council v. Gate Gourmet Div. Ams., 402 F. Supp. 2d 289, 292 (D.D.C. 2005). Such is the case here, where the legality of the government's proposed sentence depends on the Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit ("D.C. Circuit") upholding the decision in United States v. Little, No. 1:21-cr-315 (RCL), ECF No. 43. Imposing a stay will therefore allow for a fairer outcome, promote efficiency, and conserve resources for both the Court and the parties. Although the D.C. Circuit has not yet set a briefing schedule in Little, the Court is cognizant that in the only other case to appeal the issue, the Circuit ordered an expedited briefing schedule. See United States v. Spencer, No. 22- 3010, Order (D.C. Cir. Feb. 18, 2022). Admittedly, the government moved to dismiss the appeal before briefing, see id., Motion to Dismiss Appeal (D.C. Cir. Mar. 25, 2022); and the Court granted the motion, see id., Order (D.C. Cir. Mar. 31, 2022); so the issue was not substantively addressed. Nonetheless, after balancing the competing interests, the Court is persuaded that a stay is warranted in the interest of "economy of time and effort." Landis, 299 U.S. at 254; because the D.C. Circuit's decision in Little will likely "narrow the issues in the pending case[] and assist in the determination of the questions of law involved," id. at 253; in view of the government's reliance on the district court's decision in Little to support its position. The parties shall submit a Joint Status Report with recommendations for further proceedings by no later than 14 days following the issuance of the decision of the D.C. Circuit in Little.
