<sup>1</sup> In its November 28, 2022 Order, the Court originally specified that "[b]ecause the current iteration of the Court's CARES Act authorization for remote hearings will expire prior to the pre-trial conference scheduled in this case, the Court w[ould] conduct this hearing in-person." Order at 1 n.1 (Nov. 28, 2022), ECF No. 50. However, because the Court's CARES Act authorization for remote hearings has now been extended through May 8, 2023, the Court will hold this pre-trial conference via videoconference.
