The Court has already entered a Due Process Procedures Act order 16, calling for full compliance with Brady and its progeny, as well as the Court's Local Criminal Rule 5.1. Moreover, the government filed a response to defendant's motion 29 on August 26, which detailed the considerable volume of material that has been transmitted to the defendant, including information directly responsive to the requests related to the Capitol Police, and asked that the motion be held in abeyance pending the defendant's review of that material and determination if anything remains to be produced. While pursuant to the Local

Rules, a reply would have been due on September 2, no reply has been filed by the defendant to date. Therefore, defendant is ORDERED to inform the Court by September 10, 2021 whether there is any reason the Court should not deny his motion as moot without prejudice to a future, more specific motion for material that in his view, remains to be produced after he has reviewed the production and conferred with the government concerning outstanding requests. MINUTE ORDER as to GABRIEL AUGUSTIN GARCIA. The Court understands that the defendant has suffered injuries that he attributes to the requirement that he wear a GPS monitor. But his recent motion does not supply any new information that would alter the assessment as to what conditions are necessary to "reasonably assure the appearance of the person as required and the safety of any other person and the community" under 18 U.S.C. s. 3142(c)(1)(B). One of the Court's stated concerns in its September 13, 2021 Order [35] was that it appeared that "the defendant may have been disingenuous with both the Court and Pretrial Services" when he traveled to Nashville for "work" purposes but then spent only approximately two to three minutes at the location identified as the purpose for the trip. Given those circumstances, monitoring above and beyond defendant's mere promise to return is warranted. And, when viewed in conjunction with all of the evidence submitted to the Court to date, the newly available evidence of statements defendant made after he left the Capitol does not assuage the Court's "legitimate concerns" about ensuring defendant's compliance with the condition of release that he "stay away from the District of Columbia." For those reasons, and for all of the additional reasons stated in the Court's last order on this topic, defendant's motion to modify his conditions of release [55] is DENIED.
