JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING HEARING

Counsel for Defendant, Jointly with the United States, hereby files this motion to adjourn the sentencing hearing, currently set for March 10, 2023, in the above-captioned matter, for approximately 60 days, until May 19, 2023, or other such date as the Court’s schedule allows. In support of the Joint Motion to Continue, the parties represent as follows:
