## **ORDER**

Before the Court is defendant's motion to admit William L. Shipley *pro hac vice* [101]. Local Civil Rule 83.2(d) instructs that any attorney seeking to appear *pro hac vice* must file a motion setting forth, among other things, a list of *all* bars to which the attorney has been admitted. The Court further **ORDERS** defendant to supplement his motion with an explanation as to why Mr. Shipley is not eligible to practice law in California.
