## Dear Judge Sullivan:

I am writing to supplement the defense sentencing submission in support of a term of probation rather than incarceration for James Bonet. Attached is a guest opinion piece in the Syracuse newspaper written by James Walsh, an upstate New York long-standing member of the Republican party and retired congressman. In his editorial, former Congressman Walsh calls out his fellow Republicans who have bought into former President Donald Trump's biggest lie -- that the election was stolen.
