ORDER

This matter having come before the Court pursuant to a Consent Motion to Continue and to Exclude Time Under the Speedy Trial Act, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the Motion is **GRANTED**; it is further

**ORDERED** that the currently scheduled hearing on October 11, 2022, be continued for good cause to January 13, 2023 at 1:00 PM; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the time between October 13, 2022, and January 13, 2023 be excluded from calculation under the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A). The Court finds that the ends of justice served by such a continuance outweigh the interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial, as a continuance will give the parties time to process, organize, review, and produce discovery and will give the parties additional time to engage in pretrial negotiations so that they can potentially reach a resolution.
