ASSENTED-TO MOTION FOR EXCLUSION OF TIME UNDER THE SPEEDY TRIAL ACT

The United States of America moves the Court to exclude the period from June 15, 2021 to the date of the defendant's arraignment. As grounds for the motion, the government states that on June 15, 2021, a federal grand jury indicted the defendant on the following charges: (1) civil disorder, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 231(a)(3); (2) obstruction of an official proceeding, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1512(c)(2), 2; (3) assaulting, resisting, or impeding certain officers, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 111(a)(1); (4) assaulting, resisting, or impeding certain officers using a dangerous weapon, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 111(a)(1) and (b); (5) entering and remaining in a restricted building or grounds with a deadly or dangerous weapon, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1752(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A); (6) disorderly and disruptive conduct in a restricted building or grounds with a deadly or dangerous weapon, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1752(a)(2) and (b)(1)(A); (7) engaging in physical violence in a restricted building or grounds with a deadly or dangerous weapon, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1752(a)(4) and (b)(1)(A); (8) disorderly conduct in a Capitol building, in violation of 40 U.S.C. § 5104(e)(2)(D); (9) act of physical violence in the Capitol grounds or building, in violation of 40 U.S.C. § 5104(e)(2)(F); and (10) parading, demonstrating, or picketing in a Capitol building, in violation of 40 U.S.C. § 5104(e)(2)(G).

At this time, an arraignment date has not been scheduled. The government requests that

this Court exclude the time until arraignment, finding that the ends of justice served by excluding the period of this continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A).

The defendant assents to this motion.
