**GOVERNMENT’S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING**

The United States of America, through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves the Court to continue the sentencing currently scheduled for Tuesday, January 31, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. for a brief time. In support of the Motion, the undersigned represents:

1. Mr. Baouche pled guilty to a violation of Title 40, United States Code, Section 5104(e)(2)(G) on August 25, 2022. At the conclusion of the hearing sentencing in this matter was set for January 10, 2023.
2. On December 5, 2022, in light of a court scheduling conflict, the sentencing was continued to January 31, 2023, at 3:00 p.m. The undersigned Assistant U.S. Attorney has a contested sentencing, in another matter, that is set for 1:00 p.m. on January 31. That matter was set by the court on November 2, 2022, prior to the sentencing in this matter being rescheduled.
3. The undersigned is requesting that sentencing in this matter be set for earlier in the day or 3:30 p.m. or later on January 31, 2023, or any of the following days that are mutually agreeable with the defendant:
  - a. Any time the week of January 30 except as reflected above;
  - b. February 8 – February 10;
  - c. February 14 - February 17; or
  - d. February 22 – February 24.

WHEREFORE, the government respectfully requests that this Court grant the motion for a continuance of sentencing in this matter to a date and time when counsel will be available.
