**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE
SENTENCING HEARING AND DEADLINES**

Josiah Kenyon, through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves this Honorable Court to continue the sentencing hearing scheduled for December 15, 2022 for at least 60 days. The defense is waiting to receive documents relevant for sentencing and anticipates that it will take a few weeks. Government counsel, who is currently assigned to the case, will not be available for sentencing after early February 2023 because her detail will have ended. However, the government does not oppose this motion. Undersigned counsel will be in a jury trial scheduled for the last week of January into early February. Hence, the defense requests a continuance for at least 60 days and a continuance of the sentencing memoranda deadlines. The parties agree that excluding time under the Speedy Trial Act is warranted because the ends of justice served by the continuance outweigh the public's interest and the Defendant's interests in a speedy trial.
