UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING

Defendant, through undersigned counsel Nathan I. Silver, II, Esq., (“counsel”) appointed by this Court under the Criminal Justice Act, with no opposition from the United States, moves the Court to continue the sentencing (by videoteleconference) from May 11, 2023, at 2 o’clock p.m. EDT, to the week of May 29, 2023, for the following reason.

Counsel received a phone call this morning from the defendant. He reported that his mother appears to have suffered a stroke and that an ambulance was bringing her at that moment to the hospital. In the circumstances, the defendant feels unable to proceed with sentencing while he is preoccupied with concerns for his mother’s health.

Counsel informed asst. U.S. Attorney Will Widman of the situation immediately after the defendant’s call. Mr. Widman advises that the government does not oppose a continuance of the sentencing. Counsel proposed to the government a period of two (2) weeks, depending on the Court’s availability; Mr. Widman advised that given his schedule, a date during the week of May 29 through June 2 will be suitable.¹

In the circumstances, the defendant moves the Court to continue the sentencing.

A proposed Order is attached.

¹ Mr. Widman is available May 29 through June 1, and on the morning of June 2; he’s unavailable that afternoon.. Counsel is available that week with the exception of the morning of Wed. May 31. The following week counsel is available without conflict.

WHEREFORE, the defendant respectfully moves the Court to grant said relief.
