**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE UNTIMELY SENTENCING MEMORANDUM AND
CONTINUE SENTENCING**

Sentencing memoranda were due to be filed with the Court by November 15, 2022. *See* Minute Entry for August 26, 2022. Unfortunately, the government failed to meet the Court’s deadline, due in part to the undersigned’s involvement as lead counsel in the ongoing jury trial of *United States v.
