MOTION FOR AN ARREST WARRANT

The AUSA withheld that request because the FBI Special Agent who is responsible for this investigation and the execution of the arrest warrant was unavailable due to illness. The agent has returned to duty. Therefore, the government requests that the Court sign the attached arrest warrant so that it may be executed.
