Financial affidavit approved. Counsel appointed.


Charges and rights were read and explained.

- (6) request transfer of the proceedings to this district under Fed. R. Crim. P. 20, to plead guilty.



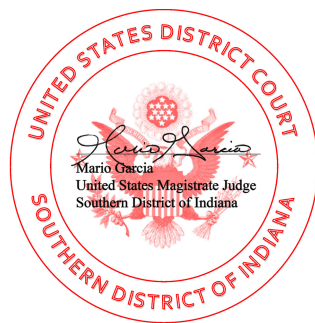
