**GOVERNMENT’S MOTION TO UNSEAL THE CRIMINAL COMPLAINT, ARREST  
WARRANT AND CASE FILE**

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully moves this Court to unseal the Complaint, Arrest Warrant, and case file, from the date of this filing forward. In support of this motion, government submits as follows:

On November 12, 2021, the government applied for and obtained an Arrest Warrant and Complaint in this matter. At that time, the government moved to seal the matter, including the Complaint, Statement of Facts, and Arrest Warrant, out of concern that disclosure of the material would jeopardize the investigation by providing the subject(s) of the investigation an opportunity to destroy evidence or flee and jeopardize the investigation by disclosing the details of facts known to investigators, the identities of witnesses, and the investigative strategy. Magistrate Judge Zia M. Faruqui signed the Arrest Warrant and Complaint, and the requested sealing order that provided that the matter would be sealed “until further order of this Court.” The Defendant was arrested pursuant to the Arrest Warrant on November 17, 2021, and he is now pending his initial appearance in Federal District Court for the Southern District of Indiana. Accordingly, the government now

believes this sealing order can be lifted in this matter, and the Redacted Complaint, Arrest Warrant, and other material can be made public.<sup>1</sup>

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons and for any other such reasons as may appear to the Court, the government respectfully requests that the Court grant this motion and enter the attached proposed order.
