JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE AUGUST 11, 2022 STATUS CONFERENCE FOR SIXTY DAYS

The United States of America, through counsel, and Defendants, through counsel, hereby move this Court to continue the status conference set for August 11, 2022, for sixty (60) days.

The parties further move the Court to exclude the period of the continuance from the computation of time under the Speedy Trial Act. In support of this motion, the parties state as follows:

- 1. On June 7, 2022, the Court held a Status Conference in this case. The parties discussed that a substantial amount of discovery had been provided to the parties, and that the Government would continue to supplement discovery. The parties also discussed the possibility of resolving this case by plea agreement, which has not occurred to date.
- 2. The parties continue to review discovery and some have discussed the possibility of pretrial disposition.
- 3. August 8, 2022, the parties agreed that the Court's Status Conference, which is set for August 11, 2022, should be continued. The parties also agreed to exclude from the computation of time under the Speedy Trial Act the time between August 11, 2022, and the next Status Conference.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, the parties hereby respectfully request that the Court grant this Motion to Continue August 11, 2022 Status Conference for sixty (60) days, and further request that the Court exclude the period from August 11, 2022 until the next Status Conference in this case occurs from the computation of time under the Speedy Trial Act.
