ORDER

(August 6, 2021)

The Court is in receipt of the parties' [20] Notice of Agreed Order to Modify Condition of Pre-Trial Release, in which Defendant requests that he be permitted to travel to the "Southern portion of Indiana" "without prior permission." Notice, ECF No. 20. Pursuant to the [10] Order Setting Conditions of Release, Defendant must "notify PSA of travel outside of the Western District of Kentucky," among other conditions. Order at 2, ECF No. 10. Defendant requests that he be permitted to travel to the "Southern portion of Indiana" without advance notice to PSA because "many residents of Louisville, Kentucky routinely travel, shop and frequent, the Southern portion of Indiana." Notice, ECF No. 20. The Court finds this to be an insufficient basis to modify the present condition of Defendant's release, and so shall **DENY** the request contained in the parties' Notice.

The Court further directs that any future requests to modify the conditions of Defendant's release should be filed as a motion and shall comply with the Court's applicable local rules. *See, e.g.,* LCrR 47.
