- 3) The Indictment in the instant matter charges Mr. Randolph with the same alleged violations of 18 U.S.C. §§ 231(a)(3), 1512(c)(2), 111(a)(1), (b), 1752 (a)(1),(2), (b)(1)(A), (B) and 40 U.S.C. § 5104 (e)(2)(D), (F) as charged in criminal matter number 21-332.
- 4) Presumably the government does not intend to proceed on both the instant Indictment and the Superseding Indictment in criminal matter number 21-332; however, the government has not moved to dismiss the latter.

Mr. Randolph respectfully moves the Court to dismiss the Superseding Indictment in criminal matter number 21-332 and direct the Clerk of Court to designate that case as closed.
