- 6. Wherefore, the defense respectfully requests a continuance of the date to file Mr. Kramer's sentencing memorandum from May 2, 2022, to May 9, 2022, and for the sentencing hearing to either remain on May 12, 2022, or to be rescheduled to a date most convenient for the Court.
