**WAIVER OF FEDERAL RULE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE 10 AND 43 RIGHT TO  
THE PHYSICALLY PRESENT FOR ARRAIGNMENT**

Richard Crosby hereby waives those rights accorded him by Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure 10 and 43 requiring that he be physically present in the courtroom for his July 20, 2021 arraignment. Additionally, he hereby provides his consent to proceed by way of remote video-conferencing technology pursuant to the CARES Act, Pub.L. 112-136, Div. B, Title V, § 15002(b)(1)(E); 18 U.S.C., Pt. II, Ch. 201. In support of this waiver and consent, Mr. Crosby states as follows:


He is represented by and has consulted with his attorney concerning this waiver;

He understands that he has a right to be physically present in the courtroom with his counsel pursuant to Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure 10 and 43;

He understands his consent to proceed remotely under the CARES act if affirmatively required but he is not required to provide it;

He understands that by signing this document he will be giving up the rights accorded him by those rules and providing his consent to proceed by remote video-conference; and

He requests that the court grant his request to convene his July 20, 2021 Rule 10 arraignment by remote video-teleconference.
