JOINT STATUS REPORT

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully files this joint status report on behalf of both parties. Defense counsel has authorized government counsel to represent that they join in this report.

By minute order of September 1, 2021, subsequent to a status hearing on the same day, the Court directed the parties to file a joint status report regarding the status of the case no later than November 1, 2021. The government filed notice on October 25, 2021 (ECF No. 20) of its ongoing voluminous discovery productions. In addition, the government and the defense continue to discuss a possibility of resolving the case.

The parties are requesting an additional status hearing in approximately 75 days and suggest January 18, January 20, or January 21, 2022 for a hearing. Additionally, the parties agree that the Court should exclude the time within which the trial must commence under the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161 *et seq.*, on the basis that the ends of justice served by taking such actions outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial pursuant to the factors described in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A), (B)(i), (ii), and (iv).

WHEREFORE, the parties request that the Court take notice of the above.
