MOTION TO UNSEAL

The United States of America, by and through the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully moves for an order to unseal the above captioned case. In support thereof, the government states that it has been advised that the case is currently sealed. The initial complaint and arrest warrant were filed under seal and the sealing order contained a provision to unseal the magistrate case upon the defendant’s arrest. The defendant was arrested on January 22, 2021 and was presented before a United States Magistrate Judge in New Jersey that same day in a virtual hearing that was open to the public. The defendant was indicted on January 27, 2021 and during a virtual hearing, was arraigned on that indictment on January 28, 2021. That hearing was also open to the public. Accordingly, there is no reason to keep the matter sealed.

WHEREFORE, the Government moves to unseal this matter.
