The proposed exhibit is as follows:

Slide 2. Defendant walking towards Capitol. “Trump supporters have broke the breach and are invading the Capitol.” 12.67 seconds.

Slide 3. Defendant continuing towards Capitol, passing downed barricades. “Storm the Capitol. That’s where the thieves are.” 28.53 seconds.

Slide 4. Defendant on the steps of the Capitol, passing downed barricades. 15.15 seconds.

Slide 5. Defendant at the base of the scaffolding. “Who cares about the cops, we’ll overpower them. 15.16 seconds.

Slide 6. Defendant on east side of Capitol taking apart barricade. 62 seconds.

Slide 7. Defendant on east side of Capitol, walking over barricades, telling law enforcement “this is war.” 62 seconds.

Slide 8. Defendant on east side of Capitol. “We do want to hurt Pelosi.” 20.02 seconds.
