




**2022.** Any *Brady* material not already disclosed also must be disclosed by this date.

5. On or before **December 27, 2022**, counsel shall file a Joint Pretrial Statement that contains the following:

a. List of witnesses. The parties shall identify the witnesses that each side anticipates it may call in its case-in-chief. Only upon leave of court and a showing of good cause will a party be permitted to withhold a witness's identity.

b. Exhibit lists. The parties shall include an exhibit list that each side anticipates it may introduce in its case-in-chief. The parties need not list any exhibit that might be used for purposes of impeachment. The parties should confer with Courtroom Deputy Jean Claude Douyon about the format of the exhibit list. The parties *should not* provide a copy of the exhibits to the court but must exchange pre-marked exhibits. The parties must be prepared to raise objections to any proposed exhibit the morning of January 17, 2023, before the bench trial commences.
