SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING HEARING

The United States of America hereby requests that this Court continue the defendant’s sentencing hearing for a brief period. This is the second continuance sought. The government is not making this request to unduly delay the sentencing or for any other improper purpose. The government has conferred with counsel for defendant, and he indicated that the government’s request for an extension of at least seven days to hold the sentencing hearing may be filed as unopposed.

The reason for the request includes the fact that the government needs a brief additional period to be able to finalize and file its sentencing memorandum as to Mr. O’Malley. The parties would ask this Court to avoid—if possible—the following dates:

- March 29
- April 4-8
- April 11

For the reasons mentioned above, the government requests that the Court grant its unopposed request for to continue the defendant's sentencing hearing for a period of no fewer than seven days.
