**GOVERNMENT’S MOTION TO UNSEAL THE CRIMINAL COMPLAINT,
AFFIDAVIT, ARREST WARRANT AND CASE FILE**

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully moves this Court to unseal the Complaint, Affidavit, Arrest Warrant, and case file, from the date of this filing forward. In support of this motion, government submits as follows:

On January 14, 2021, the government applied for an Arrest Warrant and Complaint in this matter. The affidavit filed in support of the Complaint details the facts supporting probable cause to believe that Defendant has violated Title 18, United States Code, Section 875(c) (interstate threats). The Court issued an arrest warrant for the defendant, and at our request issued an order sealing the charging materials.

The defendant was arrested pursuant to the arrest warrant on January 15, 2021. Accordingly, the sealing order now should be lifted and the Complaint, Arrest Warrant, and the case from this date forward unsealed.¹

¹ Government counsel is not aware of any counsel representing defendant so cannot represent the defense’s position on this motion.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons and for any other such reasons as may appear to the Court, the government respectfully requests that the Court grant this motion and enter the attached proposed order.
