ORDER

Based upon the representations in the Consent Motion to Continue and to Exclude Time Under the Speedy Trial Act, and upon consideration of the entire record, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion is **GRANTED**; it is further

ORDERED that the currently scheduled status hearing on Thursday, March 23, 2023, be continued for good cause to Thursday, April 13, 2023, at 1 p.m.; and it is further

ORDERED that the time between Thursday, March 23, 2023, and Thursday, April 13, 2023, shall be excluded from calculation under the Speedy Trial Act, *see* 18 U.S.C.

§ 3161(h)(7)(A).

The Court finds that the ends of justice served by the granting of such a continuance outweighs the best interests of the public and the defendants in a speedy trial, and a continuance will promote continuity of counsel, provide the defendants additional time to review the pre-indictment discovery and to continue negotiating potential pretrial resolutions.
