**CONSENT MOTION TO CONTINUE STATUS CONFERENCE AND EXCLUDE TIME
UNDER THE SPEEDY TRIAL ACT**

The United States, through undersigned counsel, hereby files this motion to adjourn the status conference set for Thursday, May 4, 2023, in the above-captioned matter until Thursday, June 1, 2023. Counsel for defendant concurs in this motion. Counsel for defendant had been on trial earlier this week in D.C. Superior Court before Judge Richter, and prior to that one-day trial had been preparing for that trial the latter part of last week. Counsel for defendant further advised that he continues to review pre-indictment discovery productions. Additionally, plea negotiations have been productive, and counsel for defendant requests additional time to fully discuss the discovery and the government’s plea offer with his client.

The parties request that the Court exclude the time from May 4, 2023, until the next status conference, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161 *et seq.*, on the basis that the ends of justice served by taking such actions outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial pursuant to the factors described in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A).
