MINUTE ORDER as to WILLIAM VOGEL: The Court held a status hearing in this case on March 4, 2021. Due to technical difficulties and with his consent, Defendant was present via teleconference. Defendant was represented by counsel, who appeared via videoconference. Counsel for the government also appeared via videoconference. During the status hearing, the Court discussed discovery and advised the government of its continuing Brady obligations in this case. See ECF No. 7. The parties also indicated that discovery has been delayed because of ongoing negotiations regarding a protective order. By or before MARCH 26, 2021, the parties shall submit a joint status report updating the Court on the status of any protective order and the status of the government's centralized system of discovery for matters related to the January 6, 2021 events. The parties shall then appear for another status hearing on APRIL 16, 2021 at 11:00 AM ET. Defendant has consented to this status hearing proceeding remotely via videoconference. During the March 4, 2021 status hearing, the Court discussed with Defendant his Speedy Trial Act rights, and Defendant agreed to exclude time between March 4, 2021 and the date of his next status hearing on April 16, 2021. Accordingly, the Court finds that a continuance of Defendant's Speedy Trial rights between March 4, 2021, and the date of the next status hearing on April 16, 2021 serves the "ends of justice" and is in the best interests of both the community and Defendant, in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and because the continuance will allow the parties to address discovery in this case. Taking into account this continuance, the Court has calculated that Defendant's new 70-day deadline is JUNE 25, 2021. The Court finds the 90-day deadline to be inapplicable in this matter. MINUTE ORDER: The Court held a status hearing in this case on April 16, 2021. With consent, Defendant was present by videoconference. Defense counsel and government counsel also appeared via videoconference. During the status hearing, the Court discussed the status of discovery with the parties and the parties indicated that discovery in this matter remains in its preliminary phases. By or before APRIL 28, 2021, the government shall produce to Defendant all discoverable information specific to Defendant in his case file, either with or without Bates-stamping. By or before MAY 21, 2021, defense counsel shall review all such discovery with Defendant and discuss any plea offer that has been offered by the government at that time. The parties shall then appear for another status hearing on MAY 21, 2021 at 10:00 AM ET. Defendant has consented to the upcoming status hearing proceeding remotely via videoconference. During the April 16, 2021 status hearing, the Court discussed with Defendant his Speedy Trial Act rights. Defendant, through his counsel, opposed the exclusion of time under the Speedy Trial Act. Nonetheless, the Court independently finds that a continuance of Defendant's Speedy Trial rights between April 16, 2021, and the date of the next status hearing on May 21, 2021 serves the "ends of justice" and outweighs the best interests of both the community and Defendant in a speedy trial. 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A). Specifically, the Court finds that the voluminous discovery and complicated "nature of this prosecution," renders this case "so unusual [and] complex" "that it is unreasonable to expect adequate preparation for pretrial proceedings or for the trial itself within the time limits established" under the Speedy Trial Act. Id. at § 3161(h)(7)(B)(ii). The exclusion of time through May 21, 2021 will allow both the government and Defendant to address and review discovery in this case, within a reasonable time frame. Taking into account this exclusion of time, the Court has calculated that Defendant's new 70-day deadline is JULY 30, 2021. The Court finds the 90-day deadline to be inapplicable in this matter.
