**UNOPPOSED DEFENSE REQUEST TO AMEND SCHEDULE FOR
FILING OF SENTENCING MEMORANDA**

The defendants in this matter were found guilty after a stipulated facts bench trial on July 28, 2023. The Court scheduled a sentencing hearing for November 29, 2023. The Court indicated that sentencing memoranda should be filed on November 3, 2023 and that responses (if any) would be due by November 17, 2023.

The draft Presentence Investigation Report was filed on October 25, 2023. Objections to the draft report are due by November 8, 2023. The current sentencing memorandum due date, November 3, is three weeks prior to the sentencing date. The defense requests that the due date for sentencing memoranda be changed to November 9, 2023. This still provides more than a week prior to the filing of any reply and is more than two weeks prior to the sentencing hearing. The government does not object to this request.
