Letter from Defendant, Michael Quick

I played football in junior High and varsity football in high school. Joined the US Army and served proudly on active duty, attended community college while serving and more classes after my service. Went to work for my mother in our family business at approximately 23 years of age. Became self employed with my two older brothers at the age 34. Donations in the community include, but are not limited to the local teachers' luncheon, Lions Club, least of these food pantry, Women's Shelter, the Highlandville Fire Department Annual BBQ raffle (to purchase and upgrade equipment) and numerous individual charities. I have inconsistently attended church but more recently over the last year and a half have been attending regularly. I spend much of my spare time outdoors and for the past year and a half learning martial arts.

I entered a relationship with Misty in the late summer of 2005 and we were living together by early 2006. She had an 11-month-old daughter, Celeste, who's biological father had never seen or wanted anything to do with her. Celeste was adorable and immediately stole my heart. Her mother was a hair dresser, and when Celeste turned 3 years old and was able to attend preschool, Misty began working the evening and weekend shifts. I would drop Celeste off at preschool in the mornings on my way to work and pick her up on my way home in the evenings. I cooked her dinner and read books to her every night. We went to the playground on weekends and spent a significant part of her childhood together just the two of us. As she got older I would help her with her homework, rode bikes, went fishing, and exploring nature. I raised her as my own daughter and she calls me dad. She has a brilliant mind and has been an honors student throughout her entire education. She loves to bake deserts, played soccer, was a leader in lab fairs, was a member of girl schouts and robotics clubs, does high school marching band, and is in AFJROTC, excelling in everything she has ever done. Countless teachers have told me that she is one of the brightest students they have ever had the pleasure of teaching. She is equally thoughtful and sweet. In grade school as she became an upper classman she started a tradition of giving the kindergartners and first grade students piggy-back rides from class to the bus. Around age 10 she started getting origami books from the library and giving her creations as gifts. I still have a dollar bill that was folded into a shirt with a collar and necktie. She has more common sense than most adults I know. She is my rock

In June of 2020 her mother and I had an argument about her car that I was fixing and she told me to leave the house. I went to stay with my brother to let things cool down. Two weeks later she moved a man I did not know from her work into my house and was now living under the same roof as my daughter. Just like that I had lost everything except for what fit into my car. In the middle of an unprecedented pandemic and political divide I was isolated, homeless, lost my daughter, fiancée, dog, and my future. My family was what gave meaning and joy to my life. After a month or so my visitations with Celeste were becoming more & more restricted. Not being the biological father I didn't have any rights. I didn't get to celebrate Celeste's 16th birthday. Due to covid there was limited seating, I did not get see band concerts, at football games on Friday nights I had to watch alone from outside the fence. It was a very painful time.

In early November of 2020 my brother-in-law whom I had a great deal of respect⁵ and admiration for had suddenly passed. Two weeks later was Thanksgiving without my daughter. The day after Thanksgiving I received a call that my best friend from high school had lost his battle with cancer. A few days later I was speaking at his funeral. On Christmas I was not allowed to have Celeste until the weekend and for only a few hours.

The irregularities of the November 3 2020 election in my opinion was a total breakdown of our voting system. I really needed a break and wanted to take a vacation but felt that I needed to

be in Washington to show that a large part of the American public had serious concerns. I felt that I needed to stand with others as a visible number and a face to a public. I felt that if a large crowd would show that we do care then maybe congress would slow down and take a closer look. A dozen senators were asking for 10 days to investigate the irregularities. That was a logical request. This was the reason I wanted to be there. I wanted to support the idea that the process not be rushed. I didn't care about the speeches. I just wanted there to be a lot of people. I am not a violent person. I did not go with malice in my heart. I was getting out of town regardless but felt if was going somewhere that it should be a place that mattered. It was more important to stand up for my rights, the rights of my family and community than to just go to some random place.

After the Rally. We had no intentions of going to the Capitol afterwards. Our party was separated and after about 45 minutes the original meeting spot at the Washington monument had fallen through. A new meeting place had been set at a statute of a man on a horse near a pool of water. Curiosity had gotten the better of me and I proceeded closer a little bit at a time until we found ourselves just outside the building. I felt justified for going through the window because the police did not seem to mind. I should have known better. I have no excuse or even the words for the poorest of poor judgement. I have paid dearly for my transgressions and am deeply regretful. Once inside after a little over five minutes I saw there was really nothing to see here and had made my way out after approximately 10 minutes.

Today is a different day for me than what the spring of 2020 to the spring of 2021. I have a hopeful future and have been rebuilding my life one piece at a time. I have new goals, new hobbies, and a few new friends. In six months time my daughter will be 18 years of age and I will be able to talk to and see her for the first time in a year and a half. Since my arrest myself and my family were no longer allowed to see or speak to my daughter. I have hopes of buying another home, growing my business, and finally taking a long overdue vacation.
