**PARTIES'S JOINT FILING OF MAXIMUM PENALTIES AND ESTIMATED
GUIDELINES CALCULATIONS**

On March 10, 2021, a Federal Grand Jury in the District of Columbia returned a five-count Superseding Indictment naming Christopher Raphael Spencer as a defendant. The Superseding Indictment charges Christopher Spencer with Obstruction of an Official Proceeding and Aiding and Abetting, 18 USC § 1512(c)(2) and (2) (Count One); Entering and Remaining in a Restricted Building or Grounds, 18 USC § 1752(a)(1) (Count Two); Disorderly and Disruptive Conduct in a Restricted Building or Grounds, 18 USC § 1752(a)(2) (Count Three), Disorderly Conduct in a Capitol Building, 40 USC § 5104(e)(2)(D) (Count Four); and Parading, Demonstrating, or Picketing in a Capitol Building, 40 USC § 5104(e)(2)(G) (Count Five).

The maximum penalties for these offenses are:

Count 1: The maximum term of imprisonment is 20 years for this Class C Felony. 18 USC § 1512(c)(2).

Count 2: The maximum term of imprisonment is 1 year for this Class A Misdemeanor. 18 USC § 1752(a)(1).

Count 3: The maximum term of imprisonment is 1 year for this Class A Misdemeanor. 18 USC § 1752(a)(2).

Count 4: The maximum term of imprisonment is six months for this Class B

Misdemeanor. 40 USC § 5104(e)(2)(D).

Count 5: The maximum term of imprisonment is six months for this Class B

Misdemeanor. 40 USC § 5104(e)(2)(G).

Acceptance of Responsibility, U.S.S.G. § 3E1.1	-3
Total Offense Level:	14
Criminal History Category:	IV (9 points)
Guidelines range:	27-33 months
