ORDER

Upon consideration of the Consent Motion to Modify Conditions of Pretrial Release filed by Donovan Crowl, good cause having been shown, it is this _____ day of April, 2021, by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia,

ORDERED:

1. That the Conditions of Home Incarceration are hereby **MODIFIED** to permit Mr. Crowl to use a flip phone, with no internet data-plan, that allows him to make voice calls and send text messages to communicate with the Court; his counsel, including a paralegal, investigator and experts working under counsel's direction to assist in the representation; with Pretrial Services; the Veterans Administration and other health care providers; and friends and family, not affiliated with the Oath Keepers; and

2. That Mr. Crowl shall be required to share his monthly phone bill that reflects call/text records with his Pretrial Services Officer, to make sure he is only using the device for lawyer communications and other permitted entities or persons.
