**GOVERNMENT’S NOTICE TO THE COURT**

The United States, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, hereby notifies the Court of the decision of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit in *United States v. Brock*, No. 23-3045 (March 1, 2024), which held that “for purposes of Sentencing Guideline 2J1.2, the phrase ‘administration of justice’ does not encompass Congress’s role in the electoral certification process.” *Id.* at 20. The D.C. Circuit’s Opinion impacts the government’s previous filings in this case, and we submit this filing in order to promptly alert the Court. The government will provide a further update after it has considered the Opinion.
