MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF PRETRIAL RELEASE

The Defendant, Daniel Egtvedt, by his counsel, Kira Anne West, hereby respectfully asks the Court to allow Mr. Egtvedt to travel to the family farm in West Virginia with his brother Rick Egtvedt to sort through personal property and to travel one day prior to checking into BOP and in support states the following:

This Court sentenced Mr. Egtvedt on March 16, 2023. He has been ordered to report to prison on April 25, 2023. The defendant is trying to get his personal property in order and as such, he would like to go to the family farm in West Virginia to deliver some of his property for storage and to sort out his personal belongings that are there in storage.

Mr. Egtvedt is asking that he be allowed to go to West Virginia accompanied by his brother, Brother Richard Egtvedt, on April 13th, 2023 until April 17th, 2023. He also requests that he be allowed to leave for reporting at FMC Devons on April 24th, 2023, so that he can stop on the way and meet with his pretrial officer in order to remove the ankle monitor. Therefore, he requests that he be allowed to leave April 24th for his reporting date on April 25th, 2023. He will be accompanied by one of his brothers on this trip.
