JOINT PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, and defendant, Joshua Lollar, by and through his attorney, Brian McDaniel, submit the following joint proposed scheduling order. In light of recent developments referenced during the most recent status conference, the trial date and other dates set forth below might be continued. In the meantime, the parties suggest the following dates:

- 1. The trial in this matter is currently scheduled to commence on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.
- 2. A pre-trial status conference is to be scheduled both for June 6, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. and for June 13, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.
- 3. All pretrial motions (excluding motions *in limine*) are to be due on April 4, with oppositions due on April 18, 2022, and replies, if any, due on April 25, 2022.
- 4. A pre-trial motions hearing (excluding motions *in limine*) is to be scheduled for May 9, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.
- 5. Motions *in limine* are to be due on May 2, 2022, with oppositions due on May 16, 2022, and replies, if any, due on May 23, 2022.
- 6. A pre-trial motions hearing for the motions *in limine* is to be scheduled for June 6, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. (the first of the two pre-trial status conferences).

- 7. April 4, 2022, is the deadline for the government and defendant to disclose a written summary of expert testimony that each party intends to use at trial under Rules 702, 703 or 705 of the Federal Rules of Evidence.
- 8. April 4, 2022 is the deadline for the government to provide written notice of all prior and subsequent acts and convictions intended to prove knowledge, intent, or other elements identified in Rule 404(b) of the Federal Rules of Evidence.
