**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

Mr. Christian Secor, through counsel, respectfully moves this Court to release the \$200,000 paid in connection with this case, to secure his bond. In support of this motion, undersigned counsel states the following:

1. On March 24, 2021, Mr. Secor appeared before the Court for arraignment and a bond review hearing. The Court set conditions of release, placed Mr. Secor on home detention, and ordered a \$200,000 secured bond.
2. For more than eight months Mr. Secor has remained in full compliance with the restrictions of home detention.
3. On November 29, 2021, at the status hearing, undersigned counsel made an unopposed oral motion to modify Mr. Secor’s conditions of release. The Court converted Mr. Secor’s secured bond to an unsecured bond, entered an Order modifying the bond, and ordered Mr. Secor to remain in the home detention program.
4. When Mr. Secor attempted to retrieve the funds, he was informed that the Court’s November 29, 2021, Order modified the bond from secured to unsecured, but did not *release the funds*.

5. The Financial Office requires a separate Order specifically releasing the funds that were paid into the court registry to secure the bond.
6. Therefore, Mr. Secor requests that this Court enter an Order releasing the \$200,000 bond.
7. There is no opposition from the government to this request.

WHEREFORE, Mr. Christian Secor requests that this Court order the \$200,000 paid in connection with this case to be released.
