**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR LEAVE TO SUBMIT A SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL
BRIEF**

John Andries, through undersigned counsel, requests that the Court permit the defense to submit a second supplemental brief by January 5, 2022. In support, undersigned counsel submits as follows:

1. On December 10, 2021, the district court in *United States v. Sandlin*, 1-21-CR-088 (DLF), issued an opinion denying a similar motion to dismiss filed by the defendant in that matter. *See Sandlin* Memorandum Opinion, ECF No. 63.
2. On December 20, 2021, the district court in *United States v. Caldwell*, 1-21-CR-28 (APM), also issued an opinion denying a similar motion to dismiss. *See Caldwell* Memorandum Opinion, ECF No. 558.
3. After reviewing both district court decisions, undersigned counsel wishes to file a second supplemental brief addressing both of the recent rulings in further support of Mr. Andries’s motion to dismiss.
4. Undersigned counsel discussed this request with government counsel, who has no objection to this request.

WHEREFORE, Mr. Andries respectfully requests that the Court permit the defense to file a reply by January 5, 2022.
