The United States of America and the defendant, through counsel hereby move this Court for a 60-day continuance of the Status Conference set for January 4, 2022, and further to exclude the time within which the trial must commence under the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161 et seq., on the basis that the ends of justice served by taking such actions outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial pursuant to the factors described in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A), (B)(i), (ii), and (iv). In support of its motion, the Government states as follows:

1. The defendant is charged by Information with misdemeanor offenses related to crimes that occurred at the United States Capitol on January 6, 2021.

2. A status conference was held in this matter on November 11, 2021, at which time the case was continued to January 4, 2022, to permit the government to complete discovery and permit plea negotiations.

3. Discovery is ongoing.

2 defendant.

4 Accordingly, the parties respectfully request that this Court grant the  
5 motion to continue the Status Hearing set for January 4, 2022, for an additional 60  
6 days from the date this Court enters an Order on this motion through and including  
7 the date of the next hearing, and that the Court exclude the time within which the  
8 trial must commence under the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161 et seq., on the  
9 basis that the ends of justice served by taking such actions outweigh the best  
10 interest of the public and Defendant in a speedy trial pursuant to the factors  
11 described in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A), (B)(i), (ii), and (iv).
