GOVERNMENT’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR RELEASE OF MEDICAL RECORDS

The United States of America respectfully submits this unopposed motion requesting a court order authorizing the D.C. Department of Corrections to disclose the full updated medical records of the defendant, James McGrew, who is currently a federal pretrial detainee at the Central Detention Facility (the “D.C. Jail”) to both parties. The order would authorize such disclosure now and any subsequent time, during the pendency of this case, that either party is preparing to file or files a motion before this Court in which Mr. McGrew’s medical history while in custody at the D.C. Jail is raised as an issue.

The government submits that the records are necessary to respond to Mr. McGrew’s Update on Medical Status and Petition for Medical Treatment (Dkt. 43), which was filed today. Counsel for Mr. McGrew also seeks a copy of Mr. McGrew’s medical records and does not oppose this motion.
