## UNITED STATES' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The United States of America respectfully submits this motion for an extension of time of seven days for filing the response to defendant's motion to dismiss.

On October 14, 2022, defendant filed a motion to dismiss count two of the second superseding indictment. The response deadline is October 28, 2022.

A brief extension for the government to file its responses to the defendant's motion is appropriate. Undersigned counsel for the United States is on detail to the United States

Attorney's Office from a different component within the Department of Justice. As such, to access the United States Attorney's Office's computer systems and files, undersigned counsel is required to log into a remote desktop. On the morning of October 26, 2022, access to that system became interrupted and, since then, undersigned counsel has been unable to access the system, despite exercising her best efforts to do so, including seeking assistance from the IT department. As such, counsel has not been able to finalize the response to defendant's motion to dismiss, and will thus not be able to file the motion by the deadline.

A brief extension of seven days will cause no prejudice, and defense counsel has represented that defendant does not oppose this requested extension.

For these reasons, the United States respectfully requests an order extending the time for the government to file its response motion until November 4, 2022.
