JOINT PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER

Pursuant to the Court’s order, the parties hereby submit this joint proposed scheduling order.

1. TRIAL. Trial of this matter will commence on February 21, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 23A - In Person before Judge Contreras as stated in the Court’s October 21, 2022 Minute Order.

2. PRE-TRIAL OR STATUS CONFERENCE. A pre-trial or status conference will be held at a date and time designated by the Court.

3. SUPPRESSION MOTIONS. Any motions to suppress statements or tangible things shall be filed on or before December 5, 2022. Opposition and replies shall be due within 14 and 7 days, respectively. The Court will schedule a hearing on the motion(s) as necessary.

4. PRE-TRIAL MOTIONS. All other pre-trial motions, excluding motions in limine, shall be filed on or before January 2, 2023. Oppositions and replies shall be due within 14 and 7 days, respectively. The Court will schedule a hearing on the motion(s) as necessary.

5. Fed. R. Evid. 404(b) NOTICE. Not later than January 2, 2023, the government shall provide notice of evidence it intends to offer pursuant to Fed. R. Evid. 404(b).

6. MOTIONS IN LIMINE. All motions in limine shall be filed on, or before, January

9, 2023. Oppositions and replies shall be due within 14 and 7 days, respectively.

7. EXPERT WITNESSES. The parties shall disclose any expert witnesses accompanied by a brief description of each witness' area of expertise and expected testimony by January 2, 2023.

8. EXHIBIT AND WITNESS LISTS. The parties shall exchange proposed case-in-chief exhibit and witness lists on or before February 6, 2023. The parties shall deliver to the Court two sets of exhibit lists and pre-marked exhibits on or before February 13, 2023.
