**UNOPPOSED REQUEST TO MODIFY CONDITIONS OF RELEASE**

COMES NOW, the Defendant, Thomas E. Caldwell, by and through his attorney, David W. Fischer, Esq., and respectfully requests that the Court modify the conditions of release in this matter, specifically to allow the Defendant to leave his home for designated DMV and banking appointments as described below, and in support of said motion states as follows:

1. On March 12, 2021, the Defendant was released on 24/7 lock-down home incarceration at his residence and GPS monitoring. To date, the Defendant has fully complied with all conditions of release.
2. The Defendant requests permission to leave his home on November 19, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 pm. for the purpose of conducting banking business, business with the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles, and related errands. These activities will be conducted in Beryville, VA, the Defendant's hometown, and the Defendant will be accompanied by his wife.
3. Assistant U.S. Attorney Kathryn Rakoczy does not oppose the instant request.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant respectfully requests that he be permitted to leave his home on November 19, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to conduct business with his bank, the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles, and related errands in Berryville, Virginia, while accompanied by his wife, Sharon Caldwell.
