**UNITED STATES’ OPPOSITION TO DEFENDANT’S  
MOTION TO CHANGE VENUE [ECF No. 46]**

The United States of America respectfully submits this opposition to Defendant Timothy Wayne Williams’s Motion to Change Venue (ECF No. 46).

Given the defendant’s waiver of jury trial, the defendant’s motion to change venue is moot, as the defendant, through counsel, has conceded. Defendant filed a motion to change venue based upon his claim that he cannot “secure the right to trial by an impartial jury.” Motion to change venue, ECF No. 46, pg. 1. Subsequently, on October 28, 2022 the defendant executed a knowing and voluntary waiver of jury trial. *See* ECF No. 48. The defendant’s subsequent waiver of jury trial moots his prior request for a change of venue based upon his claim that he cannot obtain a fair jury trial. The defendant, through counsel, agrees. Accordingly, the motion to change venue should be denied.

**CONCLUSION**

For the foregoing reasons, the Government respectfully requests that the defendant’s Motion to Change Venue be denied.
